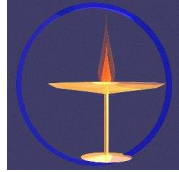


North East Indian Unitarian Pledge



At the end of the Khasi Hills annual conference of 3,000 people held recently, all stood including the children, and recovenanted with this pledge:

“We pledge to remove selfishness, jealousy, stupidity, misgiving and enmity among ourselves, so that we may build the holy religion of one God in the spirit of compassion, love and trust.... We pledge to respect other religious groups... We pledge to take care of our environment... and all forms of life in it. We pledge to respect the conscience and free thinking of all... and to support each other to uphold justice, righteousness and truth.” And then they said, “Khublei”.
